NAPLAN RESULTS

Next week your child will bring home their NAPLAN results. These results provide a snapshot of your child's performance in literacy and numeracy at the time of testing and can offer helpful information about areas of strength and areas for growth.

It's important to remember that NAPLAN is just one piece of the puzzle. It reflects how your child performed on a particular day under test conditions and doesn't capture all the wonderful things they do at school. It doesn't measure creativity, kindness, resilience, teamwork, or the individual progress your child makes each day in the classroom.

At Boolarra Primary School, we take a holistic approach to understanding each child's learning. We use a range of assessments, observations, and classroom work to get a more complete picture of your child's development and achievements.

If you have any questions about your child's NAPLAN results or would like to discuss their learning progress more broadly, please don't hesitate to contact your child's teacher.


