Student Led Reporting

We have needed to change the date for our Student Led Reporting Conversations. Notes went out on Wednesday for families to book in time slots. Please return these to school ASAP as times are allocated on a first in basis.

We have been running this type of interview for several years to increase student voice in the reporting process. Students will be showcasing some learning they are proud of and talk about how they are going in school. These conversations are a powerful way for students to advocate for their own learning.

Benefits of Student Led Conferences are:

- Families are informed of the learning at school.
- Parents see the materials and activities that students engaged in during the school day.
- Teachers, parents and students can discuss future learning plans and supportive strategies.
- Students, parents, and the teacher are all active participants in the conference.

Drop Off & Pick Up






















CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is \$125.00.

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the website https://www.education.vic.gov.au/about/programs/Pages/csef.aspx.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- New student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools this year.
- Changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings com-

From the end of Term 2 2018, all Victorian government schools are required to contact parents/carers as soon as practicable on the same day of an unexplained student absence. If your child is absent on a particular day and you have not contacted the school to explain why or the school has not been able to contact you, the absence will be marked as unexplained.
